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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

- A) The purposes for which the Classic Book Radio Corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding sections of any future federal tax code.
- B) No part of the net earnings of the organizations shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empower to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organizations shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (A) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future U.S. Internal Revenue Code, or B) by an organization, contribution to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- C) In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding sections of any future Internal Revenue Code, or shall be distributed to the ~~federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not~~ disposed of shall be disposed of by the Chancery Court of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization(s), as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
